## Team "Learn"

**Mission:** To learn about the services provided by the <u>USF Learning Commons</u>, a collaboration among the USF Tampa Library, Academic Success Center (tutoring services), the Writing Studio, the Office for Undergraduate Research (OUR), and Information Technology. Learning Commons services can be found on the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> floors of the USF Tampa Library.

**Instructions:** Each team member should have their own copy of the USF Tampa Library Directory & Map (blue sheet). Be sure that all team members know how the answers were found, so that they can explain it to students from other teams. **You have 15 minutes to answer the following questions:** 

- 1. You may need help with writing a paper for a class assignment. Go to the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor and locate the **Writing Studio**. Mark its location on your map.
- You may need help from a librarian or an LRA in locating books, articles, or other materials provided by the USF Libraries. Go to the <u>Library Services Desk</u>. Mark the location of the librarian or LRA on your map.
- 3. You may need help studying for a test. Go to the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor and locate the **Academic Success Center**. Mark its location on your map.

After you have answered the first three questions, return to the Library classroom to answer the remaining questions. Start a web browser and go to lib.usf.edu.

- 4. Before visiting the USF Tampa Library, it's helpful to know exactly when the Library is open. On the homepage, look at the <u>USF Tampa Library Hours</u> on the right-hand side. How late today could you stay in the Library in order to study?
- 5. Look at the <u>Ask A Librarian</u> area on the top right. What are the ways in which you can get help from a librarian or LRA without calling or visiting the USF Tampa Library?
- 6. Click on the <u>Tutoring</u> link on the left-hand side near the bottom of the screen. How late will the Tutoring Center be open today?
